### **What is it ?**

The White Book is a Guide, which collates the papers that Study Committee B1 *Insulated Cables* has produced from 1967 to 2007. In all more than 100 papers have been published. The White Book also lists all of the Working Groups that have worked on the papers.

The following themes have been examined – accessories, after laying tests, ageing, asset management, cathodic protection, cooling, current rating, DC cables, diagnostic, EMF, extruded cables, fault detection, environment, installation, insulation co-ordination, Overhead Lines vs Underground Cables, ratings, reliability, service experience, soil drying, space charges, special bonding, super conducting, termites, testing, water treeing, Weibull analysis.

### **What use is it?**

The White Book collates the work presented by hundreds of international experts, who have written down their knowledge on the above subjects and, as a result, it should be very useful to those interested in insulated cables

### **Who is it aimed at?**

It is aimed at all those who have an interest in Insulated Cables mainly High Voltage, varying from top executives who want to get an overview of the subject to those who want to get detailed knowledge on a specific aspect of the subject.
